Later that year, when the first Donald and Mickey dispensers hit the shelves, it soon became clear that Haas had a good nose for business – the new Disney PEZ dispensers literally flew off the shelves.

The partnership between Disney and PEZ has remained strong to this day, with a number of different Mickey ranges being released throughout the years: some with colourful accessories, some with a colourful new outfit, some classic, some retro. This year, the couple are set to make a grand entrance: Mickey in a black tuxedo with a white bow tie and Minnie in a matching turquoise dress with a string of pearls and a large bow on her

head. A more casual version is available for those who prefer something a bit less elegant, with Minnie in pink and Mickey in red with mouse prints. After all, we all need an outfit for every occasion.
